

ORDINANCE NO. 2964

**AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER REGULATE TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF
HOMEWOOD, ALABAMA, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE
VIOLATION THEREOF.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Homewood at a regular meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:

Section 1. That every person, firm, or corporation operating a motor vehicle, as defined in the Highway Code of the State of Alabama, in a northerly direction on Waverly Drive in said City shall cause said motor vehicle to come to a complete stop at the intersection of Waverly Drive. with the southerly right-of-way line of Avalon Road, as reflected on Exhibit A in said City.

Section 2. That every person, firm, or corporation operating a motor vehicle, as defined in the Highway Code of the State of Alabama, in a southerly direction on Waverly Drive in said City shall cause said motor vehicle to come to a complete stop at the intersection of Waverly Drive with the northerly right-of-way line of Avalon Road , as reflected on Exhibit A in said City.

Section 3. That every person, firm, or corporation operating a motor vehicle, as defined in the Highway Code of the State of Alabama, in a easterly direction on Avalon Road in said City shall cause said motor vehicle to come to a complete stop at the intersection of Avalon Road with the westerly right-of-way line of Waverly Drive as reflected on Exhibit A in said City.

Section 4. That no person, firm, or corporation shall park, or cause to be parked, a motor vehicle, as defined in the Highway Code of the State of Alabama, on or along Waverly Drive or Avalon Road within thirty (30) feet of the stop signs established by this ordinance and reflected on Exhibit A.

Section 5. That the violation of any Section of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, and any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions thereof, on conviction, shall be punished as provided by Section 1-8 of the Code Ordinances of the City of Homewood, or as the same may hereinafter be amended.

Section 6. That the Chief of Police of said City shall erect, or cause to be erected, appropriate lines, markings, no parking signs and stop signs at the intersections and places described in Sections 1-4 and Exhibit A hereof.

Section 7. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Homewood.
