

ORDINANCE NO. 2987

AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER REGULATE TRAFFIC ON 29TH COURT SOUTH IN THE CITY OF HOMEWOOD, ALABAMA, AS DEPICTED IN EXHIBIT A ATTACHED HERETO, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Homewood at a regular meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:

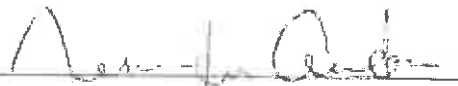
Section 1. That every person, firm or corporation operating a motor vehicle, as defined in the Highway Code of the State of Alabama, on 29th Court South shall travel in an easterly direction only.

Section 2. That the violation of any Section of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions thereof, on conviction, shall be punished as provided by Section 1-8 of the Code Ordinances of the City of Homewood adopted and approved by the City Council and Mayor of the City, or as the same may hereinafter be amended.

Section 3. That the City shall erect, or cause to be erected, appropriate lines, markings, signs as described in Section 1 hereof and Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 4. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Homewood.

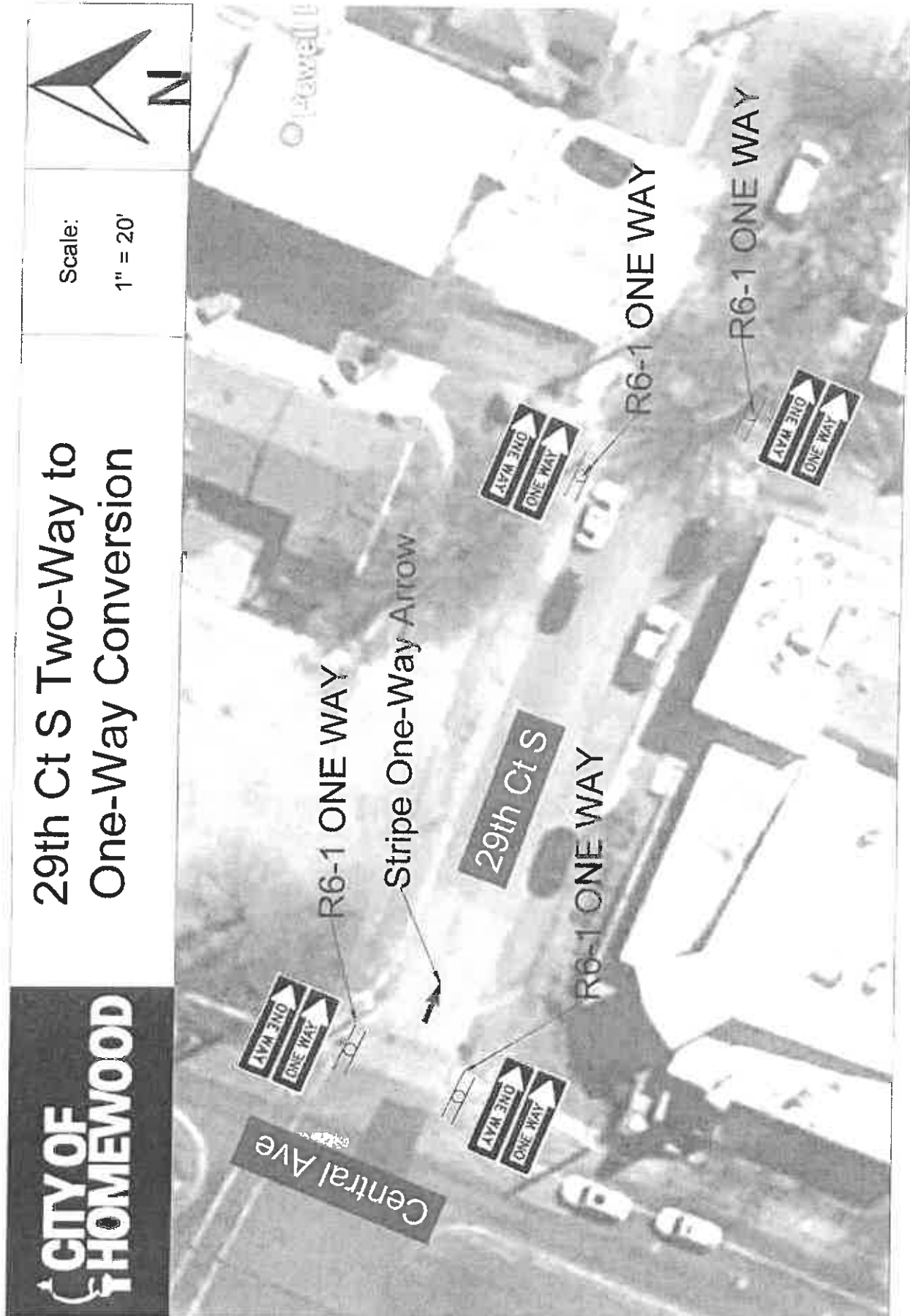

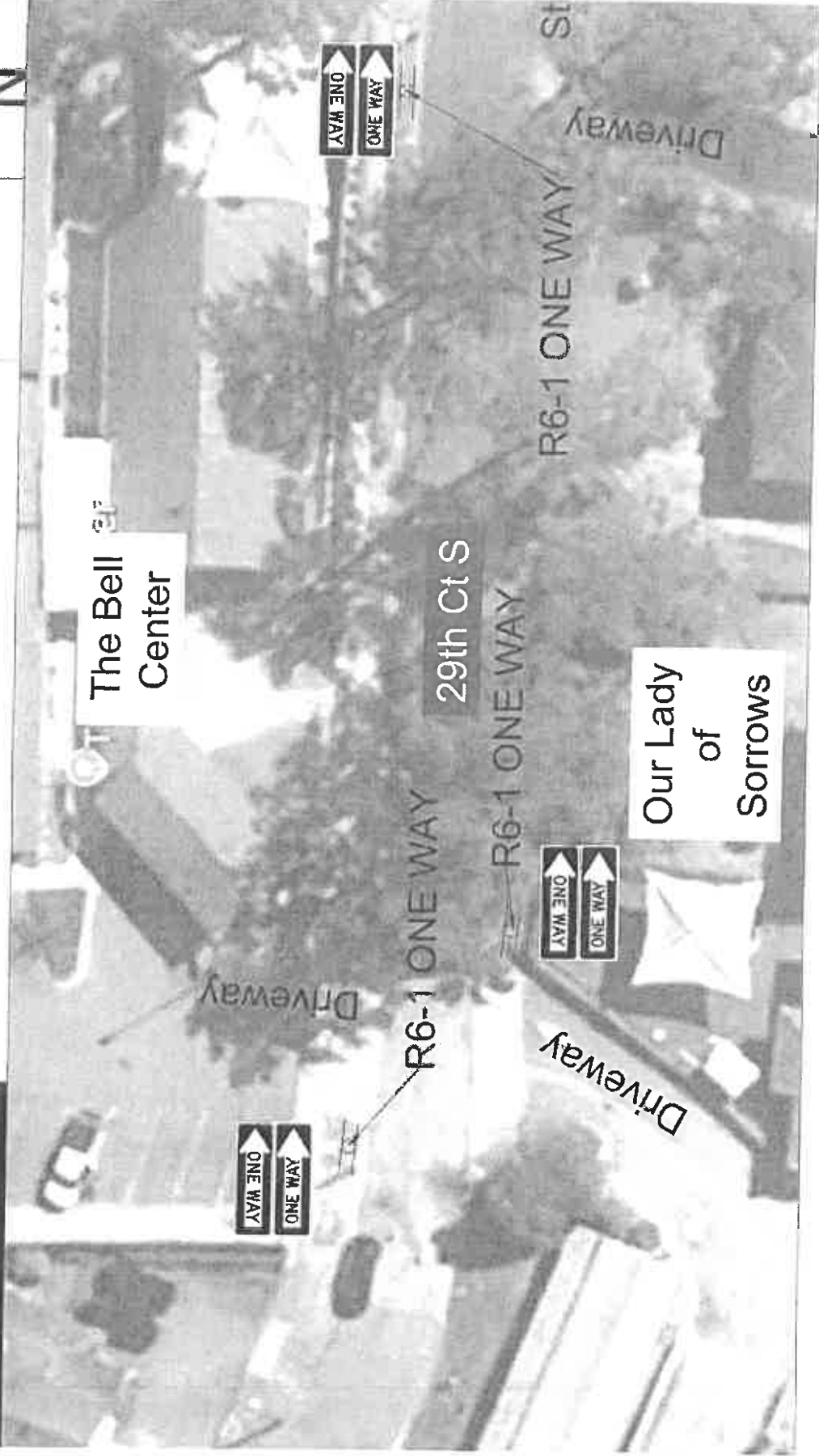
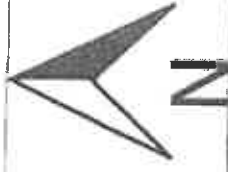




29th Ct S Two-Way to One-Way Conversion

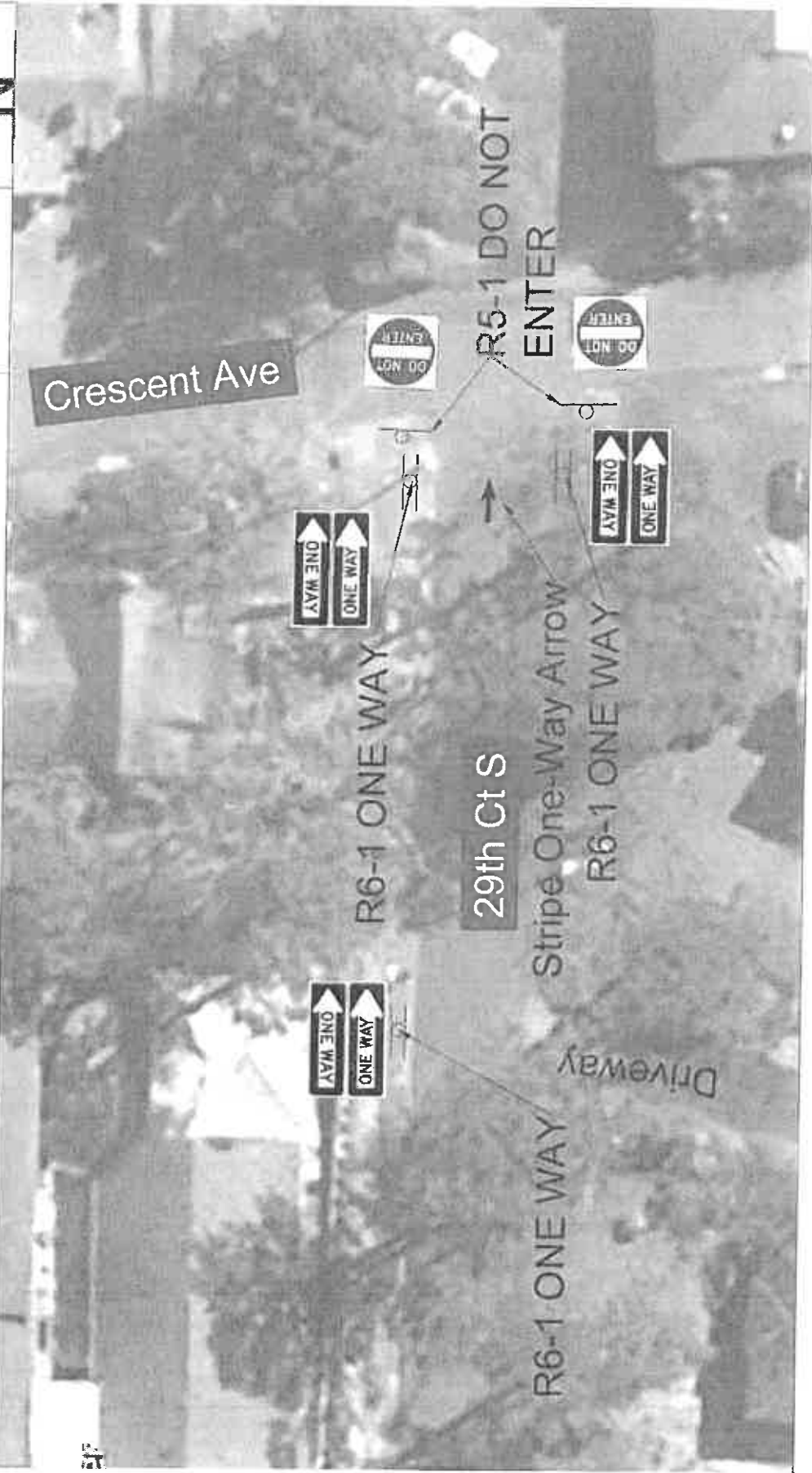
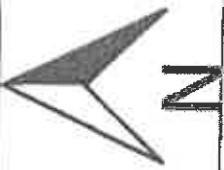
