ORDINANCE NO. 2989

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RESCIND ORDINANCE NO. 1718, ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMEWOOD, ALABAMA, ON MARCH 26, 1990

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Homewood adopted Ordinance No. 1718 on March 26, 1990, which was codified as Chapter 9, Article IV of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Homewood;

WHEREAS, the City of Homewood has changed its form of government to a Council-Manager government as authorized by the Council Manager Act of 1982;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Ordinance No. 1718 is no longer appropriate for the current administration and operation of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the public interest to repeal and rescind Ordinance No. 1718 in its entirety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMEWOOD, ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1718, adopted by the City Council of the City of Homewood, Alabama, on March 26, 1990, is hereby repealed and rescinded in its entirety.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. If any part, provision, or section of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, all other parts, provisions, and sections of this Ordinance not thereby affected shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, or as otherwise becoming law.
