
About **SIMS GARDEN**

Future Plans

PARKING SPACE
single parallel parking spot

GRAVEL DRIVE
service access to back of greenhouse/pavilion.

GREENHOUSE, GARDEN SHED & PAVILION
primarily wooden structures with stone accents at base of columns.

BRICK DRIVEWAY

FERN GLADE
planting palette comprised of predominately fern species intermixed with other shade loving perennials & shrubs. existing trees are mostly retained.

DRY CREEK BED
stone creek bed to catch water overflowing from neighboring property.

BOULDER FOUNTAIN
boulder fountain on centerline with terrace steps.

BIORETENTION FEATURE
water from the adjacent property is intercepted and redirected into a feature that artfully showcases green infrastructure and shapes the garden's spaces.

DRY CREEK BED
stone creek bed to act as overflow conveyance for bioretention in heavy rains.

RESTROOM
single user restroom.

MEANDERING GARDEN PATHS
natural or rubberized bonded mulch.

RAIN WATER CISTERNS
modular system of cisterns to collect runoff from roof.



FACADE RENOVATION
an extension of the house's entry.

BIORETENTION
as rainwater exceeds capacity, overflow is directed to a conveyance pipe underneath the new driveway and daylights at the curb on Highland road, planted with native species that tolerate both wet and drought conditions.

KITCHEN GARDEN

FOCAL PIECE
on axis with the walkway and muscadine arbor.

OLD FENCE LINE
low evergreen hedge works with existing concrete fence posts to create sculptural element.
