Mark 13:14a When you see the abomination that causes desolation standing where it does not belong; let the reader understand.

Matthew 24:15 When you see standing in the holy place 'The abomination that causes desolation,' spoken of through the prophet Daniel...

The Bible Describes Him In Many Ways:

The _____ Of Desolation

Daniel 9:27 ...He (the Antichrist) shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the week; He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. On the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate! Even until the consummation of all that is determined shall be poured out on the desolate.

Daniel 12:11 From the time that the daily sacrifice is abolished and the abomination that causes desolation is set up, there will be 1,290 days... (3 ½ years)

Daniel 7:7 I saw visions in the night and behold; a fourth beast- dreadful and terrible and exceedingly strong! It had huge iron teeth, it was devouring, breaking in pieces and trampling the residue with its feet! It was different from all the beasts that were before it and it had ten horns!

Daniel 7:8 While I was thinking about the horns, there before me was another horn; a Little Horn which came up among them; and three of the first horns were uprooted before it. This horn had eyes like the eyes of a man and a mouth that spoke boastfully.

Daniel 11:36-45 This king will do as he pleases. He will exalt and magnify himself above every god and will say unheard-of things against the God of gods. He will be

successful until the time of wrath is completed, for what has been determined must take place. He will show no regard for the gods of his fathers or for the one desired by women, nor will he regard any god, but will exalt himself above them all.

He will honor a god of fortresses; a god unknown to his fathers he will honor with gold and silver, with precious stones and costly gifts. He will attack the mightiest fortresses with the help of a foreign god and will greatly honor those who acknowledge him. He will make them rulers over many people and will distribute the land at a price.

At the time of the end the king of the South will engage him in battle and the king of the North will storm out against him with chariots and cavalry and a great fleet of ships. He will invade many countries and sweep through them like a flood. He will also invade the Beautiful Land. Many countries will fall, but Edom, Moab and the leaders of Ammon will be delivered from his hand.

He will extend his power over many countries; Egypt will not escape. He will gain control of the treasures of gold and silver and all the riches of Egypt, with the Libyans and Nubians in submission. But reports from the east and the north will alarm him and he will set out in a great rage to destroy and annihilate many. He will pitch his royal tents between the seas at the beautiful holy mountain.

Revelation 13:1-2 ...the dragon stood on the shore of the sea and I saw a beast coming out of the sea. He had ten horns and seven heads, with ten crowns on his horns; on each head a blasphemous name. The beast I saw resembled a leopard but had feet like those of a bear and a mouth like that of a lion.

Revelation 13:3-4 The dragon gave the beast his power and his throne and great authority. One of the heads of the beast seemed to have had a fatal wound, but the fatal wound had been healed. The whole world was astonished and followed the beast. Men worshiped the dragon because he had given authority to the beast and they also worshiped the beast and asked, "Who is like the beast?"

Revelation 13:5-6 The beast was given a mouth to utter proud words and blasphemies and to exercise his authority for forty-two months. He opened his mouth to blaspheme God and to slander God's Name and His dwelling place and those who live in heaven...

Revelation 19:19 I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him that sat on the horse (Jesus) and against His army.

2 Thessalonians 2:4-5 ...He will oppose and will exalt himself over everything that is called God or is worshiped, so that he sets himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God. Don't you remember that when I was with you I used to tell you these things?

Acts 17:1-3 ...they came to Thessalonica, where there was a Jewish synagogue. ...Paul went into the synagogue and on three Sabbath days he reasoned with them from the Scriptures, explaining and proving that the Christ had to suffer and rise from the dead. "This Jesus I am proclaiming to you is the Christ," he said.
