

Our priorities for 2026 (final).

1. Broadening our volunteer force

We will foster wider community involvement in the park and strengthen our shared identity by improving how we promote volunteer work.

2. Conserving and improving the park's environment

We will enhance both the natural and built features of Broomfield Park, ensuring its beauty, biodiversity, and heritage are protected and improved for future generations.

3. Celebrating heritage

We will work with Enfield Council and heritage partners to secure a phased plan for memorialising Broomfield House and to develop an ongoing heritage strand within FoBP.

4. Increasing public engagement

We will improve awareness of FoBP's work and attract new visitors by offering inclusive events and activities that celebrate Broomfield Park's heritage, nature, and community spirit.

5. Strengthening partnerships

We will work with Enfield Council, Palmers Greenery Community Café, and other local organisations to share expertise and deliver joint projects for the benefit of park users.

6. Strengthening financial management

We will continue to improve our financial processes to ensure transparency, accountability, and that all funds are directed towards our charitable objects.
