Huntington Auxiliary's Expansion Initiated as Altadena Guild Born

WHEN AN ANNIVERSARY comes 'round, it is nice to mark it with something more tangible than just a celebration. 1951 will stand out importantly in the records of the Women's Auxiliary to Huntington Memorial Hospital for the tangible, far-reaching venture which it is announcing this morning through its president, Mrs. L. J. Patee.

A plan to enlarge and extend the work of the auxiliary, which came into being 25 years ago as the result of the 926 Tournament of Roses grandstand disaster, has been undertaken by means of the organization of smaller and extremely active units throughout the area served by the hospital.

To be known as guilds of the hospital auxiliary, these groups are in the process of

forming. First fledgling to make its appearance is the Altadena Guild, organized Friday afternoon at a tea in the home of Mrs. Fred C. Nash on Porter Drive.

Mrs. Harold A. Smith, chosen as president, is to be assisted by eight other members of a governing board: Mrs. Berry A. Baxter as first vice-president; Mrs. Nash, second vice-president; Mmes. Lee M. Meriman, recording secretary; Philip S. Fogg, corresponding
