Post-Filing Public Notice of Assignment Application for Station WALQ(AM)

- Broadcast the on-air announcements at least once per week (Monday through Friday) for four (4) consecutive weeks, for a total of six (6) broadcasts with no more than two (2) broadcasts in a week. Broadcasts in a single week shall not air on the same day.
- Date for commencement of broadcast of the announcements: the first on-air announcement must begin within 5 business days of October 26th--the date the FCC released the "acceptance public notice" for the application. Thus, start the Public Notices on or before November 2, 2023.
- All on-air announcements shall be broadcast between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.
- Website notice: The text of the public notice must be posted online in a prominent manner by posting a conspicuous "link" labeled "FCC Applications" to the text on the website of WALQ or Hughey Communications, Inc. or another website accessible to the public which is locally targeted (e.g., local government website, local community bulletin board, or state broadcaster's website) -- and keep it on the website for at least 30 days.
