



South Carolina United FC Competitive Soccer Financial Obligations

There are several components to the financial commitment to play Competitive Soccer with South Carolina United FC.

Once a player has accepted his/her position the parents of the player are responsible for the required fees set forth below, even if the player does not play the entire Fall and/or Spring seasons. A player will not be granted a release from SCUFC until all required fees are paid in full and the player is in good standing with the club.

<p>Evaluation Fee <i>(Required)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● This fee must be paid before a player can be evaluated for a competitive team. ● Paid directly to the club online at www.southcarolinaunitedfc.com via credit or debit card.
<p>CLUB FEES (All-In) <i>(Required-paid in PlayMetrics)</i></p> <p>Paid directly to the club online in PlayMetrics via credit or debit card at www.southcarolinaunitedfc.com</p> <p>Payment plans are available and selected at registration.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Club Fees include league fees, referee fees, state cup fees, training fees, goalkeeping training, administrative expenses, maintenance expenses, insurance expenses, capital improvement expenses and other overhead expenses necessary to operate and maintain the organization. The current Club Fee chart can be found on our website at www.southcarolinaunitedfc.com. ● Club Fees are inclusive of Team Operating Fees which cover Tournament/event entry fees, coach travel expense for tournaments (hotel, per diem and mileage) and league game travel expenses (games outside of greater Columbia/Lexington) ● Failure to pay club fees can result in player suspension. <p>Financial Assistance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Financial Aid is available for Club Fees on a needs-based basis to the extent that there are funds available. ● Please apply for Financial Assistance in PlayMetrics and complete the application. Only fully completed applications with supporting documentation will be considered. ● Aid will be awarded after candidate's application is reviewed and any additional required information is provided to the Financial Aid Committee.
<p>Acceptance Fee <i>(Required)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● This is the standard Acceptance Fee that all members pay to participate in our programs. ● Paid directly to the club online when accepting team position. ● This fee is non-refundable after accepting your team position online.
<p>Volunteer Buy Out Fee <i>(Optional in lieu of working required volunteer hours)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Each family is required to volunteer a minimum of 5 hours per year. ● Any player's parents who choose to buy out of working these hours can pay the \$150 Volunteer Buy Out Fee (\$150 per family per year) ● Paid directly to the club online when accepting team position. ● Fees for unworked hours will be billed to the player's account at the end of the season.
<p>Uniform Kit Fee <i>(Required for ALL PLAYERS for the 2026-28 season)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Every player is responsible for purchasing a SCUFC PUMA uniform kit during the active 2-year uniform kit cycle (current cycle is 2026-2028). The 2026-28 kit includes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 2 game jerseys ● 2 game shorts ● 2 pairs of game socks ● 1 training kit (2 jerseys, 1 pair shorts and 1 pair socks) ● 1 team hoody. ● New to club players are also required to order the Team Backpack. ● Ordered and paid directly to Soccer Village via the Team Hub website link that is emailed to you after team registration is completed (including payment). Soccer Village is your contact for any questions.
