Another Presidential Cadillac Adventure

I thought you might enjoy another road tripping travel adventure with SNOWBALL, my SRX Cadillac. I left Las Vegas and headed East to Flagstaff Az paralleling Route 66 out of Kingman. The plan for some more leaf-peeping after a beautiful trip to Mount Charleston. It is a long all uphill trip to Flagstaff.

Interstate 40 has deteriorated—the rode has become very bumpy and potholed since the last time I traveled this direction many years ago. Trucks were EVERYWHERE! Seligman, which is on the east end of Route 66 out of Kingman was a stop for gas and just to look around a bit and be reminded of what road travel used to be like. After a few minutes, Snowball headed down the road to Williams Arizona where I had lunch and where I got to buy a new coat commemorating Route 66. It

seems I had forgotten to bring mine with the temperature expected in 30s in Flagstaff. So now I have a nice Route 66 themed coat.

Leaving Williams, the GPS, we call Jessie, informed us there was a 10-minute delay just short of our turn into Flagstaff on I40, so I decided to take the recommended GPS detour. The side trip took us on a dirt part of old Route 66 and a through Forrest Service land (I learned quickly the meaning of FS road).

I climbed to over 8,000 feet. The road was one-lane rutted and damp because the snow two days before. Talk about testing my driving skills! Yes I did meet a couple of cars going the other way on that one-lane road. It was interesting to say the least. There were lots of fir trees and a fence made of old snow skis. By the time we cleared the Forest Service land SNOWBALL was an interesting shade of orange and in need of a bath. Who would think that I would ever go off-road in a Cadillac.

After the slight detour, on the way into town, the first stop in Flagstaff was the Museum of Northern Arizona. It is a museum not to be missed with a Native American focus and dinosaurs.



The next day, Snowball headed to Sunset Crater Volcano and Wupatki Pueblo. It had been a while since I had been through the two parks and I have always enjoyed. An THEN it HAPPENED! After looking around Wupatki Pueblo, I headed to the car to go back to Flagstaff. SNOWBALL WOULD NOT START! She would not even turn over a little. There was no cell service or internet this far from Flagstaff. One of the local's heard the cough of the Cadillac and helped us with a jump. It took 2 tries to get Snowball going.

Snowball limped back the 25 miles to town. It turns out the battery was over five years old. Guess it was time for new one.

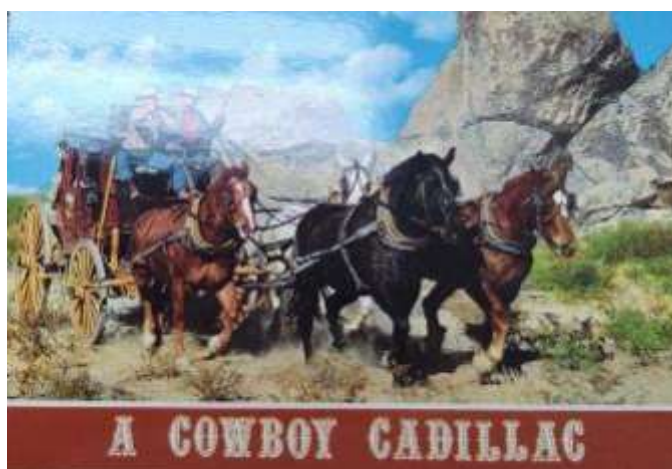
Afraid to turn the Cadillac off, I parked Snowball near the door and went into AutoZone. If a problem, lots of AutoZones in Las Vegas. It seems, however that Autozone had what we needed but they would not change the battery. There was something about the SRX had the "brain box" on top of the battery case. In any case, AutoZone would not touch it. Thank you Cadillac.

A call to the GM dealer in town was not any help. It seems they were doing inventory (only 1 day a year) and would not be open until Monday. After a number of phone calls we reached the Meineke shop in town. The good news: No issues with the alternator. The bad news: a new battery in a small town. So, we had a nice long lunch at Culver's (those from the Midwest know about this great lunch place and frozen custard). I spent a bit of unexpected money to get a new battery but then Snowball was in good shape.

The next day started with a walk over to the Farmers market in the park next to our hotel. I went to watch the trains go by about every 10 minutes! I had forgotten how many trains went through Flagstaff and the backup in "traffic" that it caused. After watching a little football at Lumberjacks, I went back to the hotel to rest. 7500 feet altitude takes it out of us old guys.

It was then time to head home (no more battery issues). The wind was blowing about forty miles per hour and make for an entertaining ride in the SUV. The tumble weeds would blow across the freeway and make for a fun game of dodge ball. Just after Williams the wind picked up even more. The trucks that were empty would really lean over, at one point I thought the one just in front of me was going to fall over. Its driver side rear wheel came off the road for a split second. Made the pucker factor go up for just a second. But all was ok and I quickly passed the truck. Made it back to Las Vegas without any further adventures. I will be home for a little while.

At least I did not encounter any "loose" gravel like in the picture in the mountains. If I would have, however, had the Cowboy Cadillac I found in Seligman, I would not have had a battery or road issue—it would, however, have been bumpy. Until next time. Gary

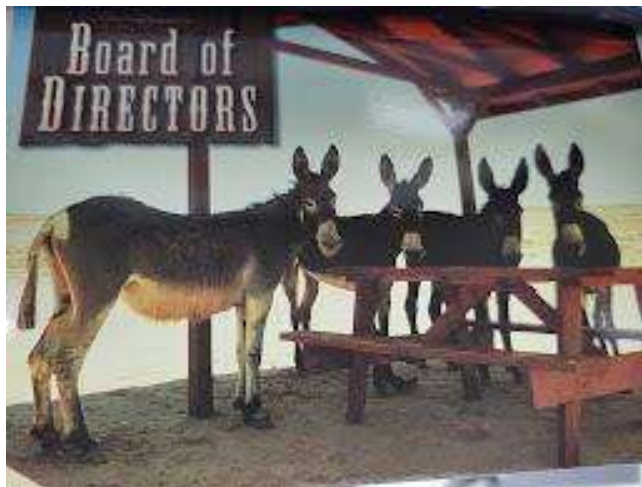

Cadillac Bucket List Item: CADILLAC FALL FESTIVAL

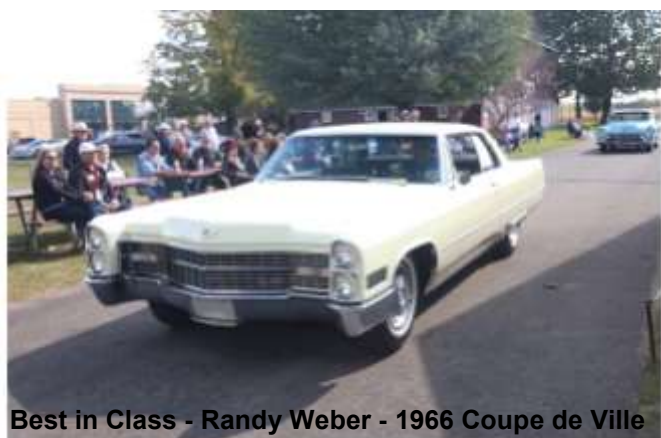


You have to make this at least one time! It really is a lot of fun and the Cadillac Museum is worth the trip in itself. It is a beautiful time of year and close enough to combine with a trip to the Henry Ford Museum and Detroit car museums or just head south to Indianapolis.

Friday, September 24th & Saturday the 25th marked the perfect time to welcome back friends, collectors and fans of Cadillac. It was the first national Cadillac Show since 2019 due to the Covid-19 shutdown in early 2020. Beautiful weather set the stage for a fun filled, safe, 2 day event celebrating Cadillacs from 1903-2021. Also spotlighted were two 2022 Cadillacs. On display was the CT5 V SERIES BLACKWING boasting 0 to 60 in 3.4 seconds and 200 miles per hour and the CT4 V SERIES BLACKWING.

Saturday afternoon wrapped up the festival with the Evolution of Cadillac Design Awards Ceremony. Master of Ceremonies and Chief Judge, Kip Wasenko, and other Cadillac designers discussed the evolution of Cadillac design as they presented the winning cars. This year each car's exterior and interior attributes were judged with an emphasis on design. Each judging team was led by a retired Cadillac Studio Chief designer and filled out with other retired and active designers with Cadillac experience and experienced CLC judges.

THE LARGEST VETERANS DAY PARADE WEST OF THE MISSISSIPPI

When is the parade? Thursday November 11th, 2021

What time does the parade start?

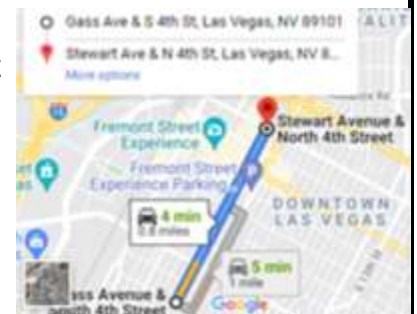

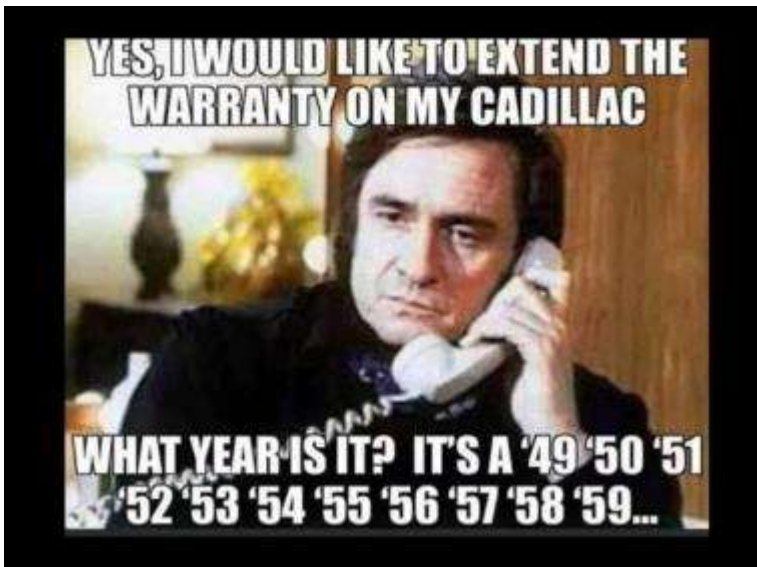
