DAY 01: USA/CANADA - HANOI (-/-/-)

Make your way to your gateway airport to board your flight to Vietnam. Enjoy inflight meals and services onboard.

DAY 03: HANOI (ARRIVAL) (-/-/-)

Welcome to Hanoi! Upon arrival at the Hanoi International Airport, meet the driver and transfer to the hotel. While it may be the modern-day capital of Vietnam, Hanoi continues to retain its mystery and charm from past centuries. Narrow lanes and traditional shophouses invite visitors to explore the city, while many of its beautiful public spaces, lakes, parks, tree-lined boulevards, and monuments give the city an air of elegance and harmony with nature that is unique among Asian capitals.

DAY 04: HANOI (B/-/-)

This morning, after breakfast, discover Hanoi's cultural treasures with half day city tour of Hanoi. Begin your day with the visit to the historic **Ba Dinh Square**, where President Ho Chi Minh proclaimed independence on September 2, 1945, establishing the Democratic Republic of Vietnam and is venue for state events. Afterwards, continue your visit to the **Ho Chi Minh complex** (Ho Chi Minh mausoleum, the presidential palace, house on stilts final resting place of Uncle Ho, where He lived and worked from (1954 - 1969). Next take a walk along the famous **Train Street**, a unique and lively neighbourhood where trains pass just inches from local homes and cafés. Take some time to relax and soak in the atmosphere while enjoying a drink at one of the Train Street cafés (at your own expense). Return back to the hotel for rest of the afternoon at leisure.

DAY 05: HANOI - HALONG BAY - HANOI (B/L/-)

Embark on today's tour to **Ha Long Bay**, a journey filled with captivating landscapes, mesmerising islets, and intriguing caves, with a special visit to Titov Island for a panoramic view of the entire bay. The Halong Cruise will guide you through a journey, traversing a route renowned for its striking passages, uninhabited islets, and creatively named outcrops like Cock Fighting and Thumb Island. Indulge in a Vietnamese lunch onboard. In the afternoon, explore the **Bo Hon archipelago**, visiting the Surprising Cave to witness stunning stalagmites and stalactites resembling various sea life forms. Then, enjoy kayaking or a bamboo boat ride in Luon Cave to discover the beautiful lagoon. Later, a visit to **Titov Island follows**. Sail back toward Tuan Chau Harbour. You will then be dropped off at your hotel, marking the end of this enchanting trip.

DAY 06: HANOI - NINH BINH - HANOI (B/L/-)

Enjoy a full-day journey to **Ninh Binh**, beginning with a scenic drive through the peaceful countryside. Visit the historic **Hoa Lu Ancient Citadel** and explore the temples of King Dinh and King Le before enjoying a leisurely bicycle ride along rural roads, past canals, villages, and dramatic limestone mountains. After a local lunch, continue to **Tam Coc**, where a traditional sampan boat ride takes you through a stunning landscape of limestone karsts, serene rivers, caves, and sacred temples. Later, head to Mua Cave and climb Ngoa Long Mountain for breathtaking panoramic views over the rice fields and surrounding natural beauty before returning to Hanoi.

DAY 07: HANOI - HUE (Flight) (B/-/-)

Transfer to the airport, in time, for your flight to Hue, the Imperial heartland of Vietnam. Arrive, meet and greet followed by transfer to the hotel. Rest of the afternoon is free for you to relax and enjoy your hotel facilities or explore the surroundings on your own.

DAY 08: HUE - HOI AN (B/L/-)

Recognized by UNESCO as the 1st Cultural World Heritage for Vietnam, Hue is highlighted by the old royal architectural works and The most traditional Vietnamese lifestyle. Your day begins with the visit to intricate **Khai Dinh Tomb** before enjoying a local speciality Lunch and a relaxing herbal foot bath. Later discover the city's charm from the **Royal Citadel, Forbidden City**. Next visit the iconic **Thien Mu Pagoda**, a symbol of Hue's spiritual heritage. Later in the evening return to the hotel to check out and take the scenic drive through world renowned Hai Van Pass to Hoi An. Arrive and check in at the hotel for overnight

DAY 09: HOI AN (B/-/D)

Spend the morning at leisure. Later in the afternoon, depart for **Cam Thanh Fishing Village** and enjoy a bamboo basket boat ride through the tranquil coconut forest. Experience local life with net fishing, crab catching, a lively basket boat performance, and a visit to a fisherman's home for a refreshing drink. Later, explore the charm of Hoi An Ancient Town, including the **Phuc Kien Assembly Hall**, a historic ancient house, and the iconic Japanese Bridge. In the evening, enjoy a light local dinner and end the day with a peaceful boat ride while releasing flower lanterns for luck and happiness. After the tour, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Hoi An.

DAY 10: HOI AN - HO CHI MINH (FLIGHT) (B/-/-)

Breakfast at the hotel. Later in time transfer to the Danang airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh city. Arrive, meet and greet followed by transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure to explore the surroundings.
Overnight in Hoi Chi Minh City (Saigon).



DAY 11: HO CHI MINH (SAIGON) (B/L/-)

Start the day with breakfast, followed by a city tour, visit the **Reunification Palace**, the witness of the fierce Vietnam War that ended in 1975. The grand building today is a Museum and Hall of official receptions. Nearby the Palace are the colonial-styled **Central Post Office and the Notre Dame Cathedral**, built between 1877 and 1883 and one of the city's major landmarks. Our last stop this morning will be War Remnants Museum. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, we drive overland to **Cu Chi Tunnels**, an incredible underground network constructed by Vietnamese guerrillas to protect the region against the American attacks during the Vietnam War. We can even crawl into a part inside the tunnel and visit their infirmary plus kitchen to discover how people survived there. Back to your hotel later on.

DAY 12: HO CHI MINH - SIEM REAP (BY FLIGHT) (B/-/D)

This morning you will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Siem Reap, Cambodia. Upon arrival at the Siem Reap International Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. You will have dinner with Apsara, the **traditional Khmer dance** - drama performance, which are not merely dance but also telling a story.

DAY 13: SIEM REAP (B/L/-)

After breakfast, gear up the exploration of **Angkor complex temples**, the UNESCO World Heritage by first visiting the ancient capital of Angkor Thom which is famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone. Visit **Bayon Temple** - unique with its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces, **Baphuon temple** located in the North of Bayon represented of holy Mount Meru the residence of the gods in Hindu tradition. Continue visiting the jungle covered temple of **Ta Prohm**. There are enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers which embrace themselves in the stone foundations of the structure giving the impression of man's creation being reclaimed by the powerful forces of nature. This temple is famous by being chosen for major activities of Tomb Raider acted by Celebrity Angelina Jolie. Afternoon, visit **Angkor Wat**, highlighted by the longest continuous bas-relief in the world, carved on the walls and tell the stories of Hindu legends. This architectural masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. Strolling around this massive edifice, seeing many galleries with Columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple.

* The upper level of the Bayon temple is closed for renovations. The land parts remain open as usual. Visitors will still be able to visit the Bayon temple on the lower level as well as all other Angkor temples as per schedule. * During the visit to the Bakan tower of the Angkor Wat temple, visitors must wear appropriate attire, covering the shoulders and knees, as this temple is still considered a holy place (shorts or miniskirts are not allowed). Children under the age of twelve are not allowed to climb this tower. It will be closed on Buddhist Sabbaths, Buddhist religious days, four days a month according to the lunar calendar. (**To climb the Bakan tower, now only 100 people are allowed to enter at a time, so visitors have to queue).

DAY 14: SIEM REAP (B/-/-)

Discover life on the water with a visit to **Tonle Sap Lake**, Southeast Asia's largest freshwater lake and a vital lifeline for millions of Cambodians. Travel by boat to the floating **village of Chong Kneas**, where stilted houses, floating markets, and local fisheries form a unique community adapted to the changing water levels. Observe the daily routines of local fishermen, visit a crocodile farm, and see how residents live and work on the lake. Along the way, take in the breath taking scenery and look out for water birds that thrive in the seasonally flooded forests surrounding the lake. (Please note: The tour runs from 8:00 AM to noon.) In the afternoon, enjoy free time to explore the vibrant city of Siem Reap at your own pace. You may wish to visit local markets and shopping areas such as the Old Market (Psar Chas), Angkor Night Market, or Pub Street, where you can shop for Cambodian handicrafts, silk products, souvenirs, spices, and local artwork while experiencing the lively atmosphere of the city.

DAY 15: SIEM REAP (DEPARTURE) - USA/CANADA (B/-/-)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight back home.
