Penticton Chamber announces launch of Top 40, presented by Kettle Valley Memorial

Recipients will be chosen by a selection panel composed of respected and experienced business and community professionals who will independently evaluate each nominee's accomplishments in leadership, vision, innovation and achievement in their field, impact and positive influence on others, and their commitment to social responsibility and community involvement.
