

Supreme Court Case Update: June 2026

The Black Farmers and Agriculturalists Association (BFAA) remains committed to keeping our members and supporters informed regarding the ongoing legal case involving our fight for fairness, accountability, and equal access within the agricultural system.

On June 10, 2026, an important procedural step occurred in our case currently before the Supreme Court of the United States. A Petition for Writ of Certiorari was officially filed, requesting that the Supreme Court review the decisions made by the lower courts.

The case is:

Black Farmers and Agriculturalists Association, Inc., et al. v. Brooke L. Rollins, Secretary of Agriculture, et al.
Case No. 25-1369

At this stage, the Supreme Court has not yet decided whether it will hear the case. The filing simply means the Court has been formally asked to review the matter.

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has until July 10, 2026, to file its response to the petition. Once all filings are submitted and reviewed, the Supreme Court will determine the next step in the process.

We understand how important this case is to Black farmers, landowners, and agricultural families across the country. This legal effort represents more than a court proceeding. It reflects the continued fight for justice, equity, and meaningful access to opportunities that have historically been denied to many in our community.

BFAA will continue to monitor all developments closely and will share updates as new information becomes available.
