As I continue to get used to *our* parish, I am more and more impressed and humbled. Thank you again for being so welcoming!

As a way of letting you get to know us, I will continue with the list of "New Priest Questions."


**At what moment did you realize you were called to ministry, and why as a diocesan priest?**

This is not something I thought of as a young man in elementary or high school. Nor was it something that was presented to me. Later on, I would come to see that priestly life was always the Lord's plan for my life. It only became known to me in my mid-20's as I was questioning, and along with that questioning, began living my faith in a more profound way. This was further brought on by the events of 9/11/2001 and the needed consideration of evil, suffering, free will and distinctions between religions and denominations. By His grace, this drew me closer to Christ.

At the same time, as I considered what I thought was inevitable, marriage and family, the church was going through a time of suffering due to the egregious sins of many priests. I can remember this bothering me... "how could men called to serve the Mysteries of God's Mercy do such things?" It was at this time that the idea of a call to the priesthood slowly began to come to me. As I considered it more, it became more and more attractive... a gift from the Lord. Any vocation is a gift freely given by the Lord to be freely received. Entering seminary further drew me to the priesthood.

I am especially attracted to parish life as the parish is most likely connection point in a community to the Body of Christ. It is at the parish, especially when there is a school and religious education, that allows for care for families and the faithful at all the stages of life. This, of course, is something that all of us have a role in. I look forward to serving together in these aspects of parish life.

**Queridos amigos en Cristo,**

A medida que me voy familiarizando con *nuestra* parroquia, me siento cada vez más impresionado y honrado, ¡Gracias de Nuevo por su amabilidad! Para que nos conozcan, les comparto la lista de "Preguntas para nuevos sacerdotes".

**¿En qué momento se dio cuenta de su llamado al ministerio y por qué como sacerdote diocesano?**

Esto no es algo en lo que pensara de joven, en la primeria o la secundaria. Ni fue algo que me presentaron. Más adelante, llegaría a comprender que la vida. Sólo lo supe a mediados de mis años veintes, cuando me cuestionaba, y junto con ese cuestionamiento, comencé a vivir mi fe con mayor profundidad. Esto se acentuó aún más con los sucesos del 9/11/2001 y la necesaria consideración del mal, el sufrimiento , el libre albedrío y las distinciones entre religiones y denominaciones. Por Su gracia, esto me acercó más a Cristo.

Al mismo tiempo, mientras consideraba lo que creía inevitable, el matrimonio y la familia, la iglesia atroces pecados de muchos sacerdotes. Recuerdo que esto me molestaba, "¿Cómo podrían hombres llamados a servir los Misterios de la Misericordia de Dios hacer tales cosas?" Fue en ese momento que la idea del llamado al sacerdocio comenzó a surgir lentamente en mí. A medida que lo pensaba más, se volvió cada vez más atractivo... un don del Señor. Toda vocación es un don gratuito del Señor para ser libremente recibido. Entrar al seminario me atrajo aún más al sacerdocio. Me atrae especialmente la vida parroquial, ya que es probablemente el punto de conexión de una comunidad con el Cuerpo de Cristo. Es en la educación religiosa, donde se cuida a las familias y a los fieles en todas las etapas de la vida. Esto, por supuesto, es algo en lo que todos tenemos un papel. Espero con interés servir juntos en estos aspectos de la vida parroquial.
