WEEK FOUR:

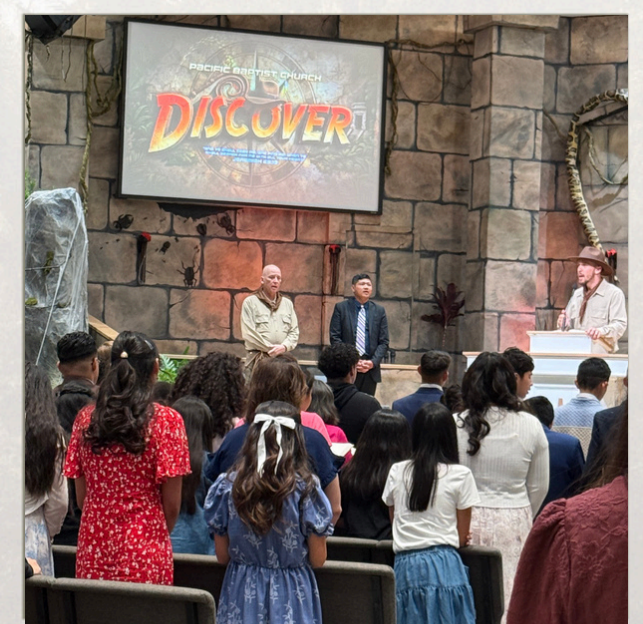
