Alaska Basketball Camp — words can hardly describe the great need and opportunity amongst the native peoples of Alaska. There are 229 federally recognized Native Tribal Groups in the state. We were with the Inupiaq and Yupik peoples in the Villages of Unalakleet, St. Michael and Stebbins. We were surrounded by the beautiful creation of God and 18+hrs of daylight but the spiritual darkness could be felt. The similarities of the people to our Navajo and Zuni people were abundant. There is a great opportunity to reach people in these villages with the Gospel, it will take some of God's choice servants to thrive in this harsh environment, but the eternal reward will be unimaginable. There are people everywhere in this world and the greatest need that they have is to receive the Salvation of God through our Lord Jesus Christ. How shall they call upon Him, believe in Him and hear of Him unless we who have the good news go. God is still calling, let's be listening.
