Our journey to Mountain View Baptist Church and Lukachukai, AZ on the Navajo Nation began in October of 2025, when we went there for a service praying about the possibility of a move in the future. The immediate response of my heart was "Yes, Lord" but we waited to exercise patience in prayer and went back for services in November and December. Each time we went there the burden for our people and for the lost souls in the area grew but it was a real exercise in patience to balance desire with God's leading. Let me assure you that God has been leading! In my devotions, study and message preparation, preaching and

teaching God has not only been preparing me and our family but also preparing the people.

At Mount Calvary Baptist Church, several men have taken steps forward in salvation, surrender and service to the Lord. God sent a man from the area to Mount Calvary who was by his own admission contemplating suicide, to surrendering his life to the Lord and desiring to be used by God. Two men have been regularly going to the jail services in Zuni and helping there. A father and daughter who this time last year were hopelessly drunk and high on drugs have been saved, sober and growing in Christ after receiving help from the City of Refuge and Hope Homes. They were both baptized last Sunday!

I believe that God is moving our family to multiply effective witness across our reservation. Only God knows the number of souls that are afflicted by sin in the Northern Navajo Reservation where we are headed but I do know that JESUS is "able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him..."

Beginning March 8th we will be traveling the 270-mile round trip from Ramah, NM to Lukachukai, AZ for services twice weekly until we can establish a dwelling place on the church site. Our plan, God willing of course, is to be completely moved over there by July; to accomplish this goal we need to renovate a 13'x60' mobile home that is on site and build an addition for adequate living space. I believe our first year there will be crucial for us getting established in the area and focusing on discipleship with the people of Mountain View Baptist Church.

The theme that God impressed upon my heart for 2026 is NOW UNTO HIM from Jude 24 and Ephesians 3:20. Our life is hidden with Christ in God, we live unto Him. The church is His, and we are not to be living unto ourselves or for our glory, it is all Unto Him!

For now our mailing address will remain the same, but hopefully I will be able to obtain a PO Box in Lukachukai. Although there is a zip code (86507) there is not a regular Post office, mail is delivered to the Totsoh trading post.


