

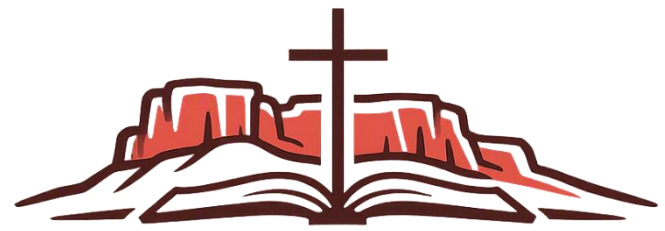

Galatians 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

This verse of scripture holds an Admonition, a Reminder, a Promise and a Condition. All Four work together for a desired purpose. Reaping. It's exciting, energizing and gratifying to reap. Reaping the harvest is only for a time. The rest of the time is spent laboring, in sowing, watering and tending to the seed.

Chinle Jail – Several preachers are interested in going to the Chinle Navajo Correctional Facility to preach. Their protocol requires all who enter to have background check and fingerprinting done prior to entering. It has been a challenge with our busy schedules this summer to get it accomplished, but several have begun the process and will soon preach in the facility.

We have much work to do on several fronts that must be accomplished to make the move to LA complete. We are in Lukachukai 90% of the time; our situation is still a continual “camp out” and living out of suitcases for the time being.

In the single wide trailer that we plan to live in we found lots of mold so we've been doing a demo and remodel. So far, we've replaced the roof, siding, windows and doors, strengthened the subfloor, hung a lot of new drywall, laid some ceramic tile and installed a mini-split heat pump. We need to replace the plumbing, lay more floor and wall tile, finish drywall, install a kitchen and 4 more split units, two of these units are going in the church building. There's a lot more that needs done but hopefully this gives an idea of the extent of the work. If you have a group or individual that is interested in helping work on any project it would be an extreme blessing,

Since our last letter we have had a men's campout which two of our men went to along with my sons and I. We also had role in the Navajo Land Baptist Youth Camp this year in Nazlini, AZ. The Jr. Camp and Teen Camp weeks were a blessing and success, there were many good decisions made, our son Caleb really put a good effort into the camp and made some great decisions along with others from the church.

We have been able to go to two different church planting conferences this year, because of the funds that were raised we've purchased 2 split heat pump units for the church and 100 tons of gravel for the entrance and parking of the church. We're very thankful for the gracious giving of God's people.

With all the physical work we're doing around the church our focus remains to reach more souls with the Gospel. Discipleship must be our outlet to reaching new people. We have come to find that most of the church has never been properly disciplined, and physical neglect is a true reflection of the spiritual neglect in the lives of the people. Pray as we are trying to invest in multiplication evangelism, it is slower starting but with God's help we'll soon see our people reaching people. There have been several families coming from Round Rock, which is only 15 miles away. Ray from RR has been witnessing to several men he knows who are into the NAC (Native American Church). Pray for Ray's spiritual growth and wisdom.

We did a workday recently to clean the church building and the men worked together to re-roof a storage building that would surely have deteriorated beyond repair if not attended to. Working together helped bond our people to serve the Lord together.

In July we plan to help a church planter in Chinle, AZ with Bible Clubs, Teaching and transporting people, We're hosting a youth revival on July 23-24; Our VBS is on August 2-4. Pray for our people to learn to work together in serving the Lord, Souls to be saved, and lasting connections made with people in the area to reach with the Gospel.

Our Daughter Elana's Wedding August 8th in OKC; Prayer for traveling mercies and a Christ honoring wedding. Thank you all for your prayer and financial support as we labor for the Master in Navajo Land
