We had a good visit, sharing the Gospel with him again and singing several favorite hymns. His mom, Cindy came outside to hear her favorite song, "Amazing Grace" and to give a token of her appreciation, a native blanket.

The Zuni jail ministry continues to yield fruit in the form of souls coming to Christ for salvation and those who have continued to come to Mount Calvary Baptist Church after their release. Keanu, Darrel, Donald, Loretta and Lorie as well as others who have come along with them have visited the church in recent weeks.
