I once again had the privilege of thoroughly explaining to him how he could be saved, and **he told me that for the first time, he would seriously consider trusting Christ!** I was able to visit him again on March 18 to reassure him that God is real and wants to save him. We pray that we were able to show her that God, the church, and we all still love them and would love to see them come back after this year of absence. I have also had the privilege of reconnecting with Sis. YH after her recent trip to China. Since returning, she has once again been faithfully attending our Wednesday services, which is such an encouragement! Though we had not seen Sis. TW for about a month due to health and work issues, I was able to reconnect with her after her husband's birthday! Go gave him a call on his birthday, and I received an encouraging message back from the wife, saying what a blessing it was to both of them! Thank you always for keeping us in your thoughts and prayers! It truly means so much to us!*

**Church Plant:** Bro. MV has continued to grow in his personal walk with God and faithfulness to church, as well as through our weekly one-on-one visits to aid in understanding and applying Biblical truths in his life. **Special:** March 11–13 and March 26–28, we had the privilege of traveling to the western Kansai Region of Japan, first for a Bible Conference and College Graduation and second for the Teen Camp hosted by the Senri Newtown Baptist Church of Minoo, Osaka, where we first received missionary training on the field. I had the privilege of translating for the English speakers in both events, as well as leading the Teen Camp Orchestra. This year, **a young man whom we served with in Osaka, graduated to serve in full-time ministry. At Teen Camp, 120 people attended from 16 churches across Japan. At least one young national trusted Jesus as her Saviour, and one missionary's son surrendered to be a missionary to Japan!** Both events were extremely encouraging. We praise God for what He is doing in Japan!
