The past two months have been a busy season for our family. In July, we were happy to have Randy's brother and sister-in-law, nephews, and sister come for a visit. We had a great time showing our family the place that we love and have come to call home. Randy's mom, Sharon, also got to join in on the family fun before returning to the States after a year-long stay. We all spent some special times with Pastor Tho, a national pastor trained under the ministry of Randy's dad, Ray Shull.

In August we celebrated our 10th wedding anniversary and our 7th anniversary of arriving in Cambodia as missionaries. We are filled with gratitude to the Lord for His faithfulness to us.

For the past 3 months, Naomi has been doing a salvation Bible study with an elderly woman who we simply call *Granny*. When we first met her she thought she understood salvation and would even consider herself a Christian because she had attended a few programs at another church in our town. During the past two weeks, *Granny* has begun to realize that she is a sinner who can't do enough merit to save herself. Please pray that the Spirit would convince her of her need to repent of sin and turn to Jesus for salvation.

In July, Randy gave a tract a security guard at a shop in our town as he was leaving. Little did we know that God had already been working in this man's heart. Socheat (So'chee-ut) had been saved as a single man in Phnom Penh many years ago but had fallen back into Buddhism for nearly 10 years. 18 months ago, his son began having seizures on the day that he would go to the pagoda. Socheat stood in front of his son and asked Jesus to please heal his son. Jesus heard that prayer and his son has not had a seizure since that day! Socheat stopped going to the pagoda and began praying with his wife and two boys every morning. Several days before Randy gave him that tract, Socheat had been praying that God would send him someone who could give him a Bible and teach it to his family. We have been going to his house the past two Sunday mornings to teach his wife and sons about a God who loves them and is calling them to Himself. Please pray that God would keep the Evil One from snatching away the seed of the Word and pray that this family would be saved.
