Dear Supporting Churches and Friends,

We thank the Lord for each of you and your faithful prayers and support as we continue serving with Rock of Ages Ministries. Sharing what God is doing through the prison ministry is always a blessing.

This past July, we had the privilege of attending the National Rock of Ages Conference in Cleveland, TN. We were greatly encouraged by the preaching, singing, and fellowship with fellow laborers. Jerry was appointed the new Rock of Ages Western Representative during the conference, overseeing nine western states. We are humbled by this opportunity and ask for your prayers as we step into this expanded role.

This fall, Jerry will meet with a group of pastors to discuss possibly beginning a prison ministry in Canada. Please pray that the Lord will open the right doors and give clear direction.

In October, we are planning a trip to Alaska, where we will visit several prisons and spend time fellowshiping with three Rock of Ages missionary families serving there. Jerry will also travel to Spokane, WA, to preach in the prisons in that region. Then, in November, we will prepare for our annual revival at High Desert State Prison in Susanville, CA. We are praying for a mighty move of God in these upcoming meetings.

We ask you to pray for the Lord's provision for these travel expenses. Additionally, please continue to pray as we raise funds for the Western Regional Office of Rock of Ages Ministries, which is vital for oversight, encouragement, and expansion of the ministry throughout the western states.

Many ask if inmates are truly being saved and growing in the Lord. We rejoice to report that the answer is yes! At a recent prison service, we met a man who was among the first to be saved in prison four years ago. He is still faithfully playing guitar in our services and shared with Jerry that he plans to travel and sing for the Lord when he is released. Before Christ saved him, he played for a famous rock singer who passed away this past summer—but now he desires to use his talents for God's glory. We also met another man saved at High Desert Prison some time ago but has since been transferred to a facility in Solano, CA. He is still faithfully attending services and growing in the Lord! Seeing genuine fruit and perseverance among these men is a joy.

We are deeply grateful for your partnership in this ministry. Thank you for standing with us through your prayers and financial support. We could not do this work without you.
