

Professional Services:

Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff, and Overhead \$2,495

- Our services include the arrangement conference, planning the funeral, consulting with family and clergy, shelter of remains, preparing and filing of necessary notices, obtaining necessary authorizations and permits, coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. This fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs.
- The fee for our basic service and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, forwarding or receiving remains, and prices on quotes.)

Embalming \$995

- It is our policy to require refrigeration for a non-embalmed body after 4 hours.
- Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require it.

¹ Use of Facilities and Staff for Visitation. Our services include set-up, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements, attendants, and refreshments (funeral home only) during visitation.

Direct Cremation – No Ceremony

\$2,495

- Our charge for a direct cremation (*without ceremony and after First Call viewing*) includes full basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains, transportation to crematory, necessary authorizations and permits for cremation. Crematory Fees not included.
- If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are a fiberboard container or an unfinished engineered wood box. Crematory fee not included.

Immediate Burial – Graveside Ceremony 30-mins

\$4,000

- Our charge for an immediate burial (*without ceremony and after First Call viewing*) includes basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains, refrigeration and local transportation to cemetery. (Does not include Casket, Outer Burial Container or Cemetery Expenses.)

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home

\$4,635

- Our charge includes basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains, preparation of remains (with embalming), shipping container, local transportation to airport. (Airline charges and receiving funeral home charges not included.)

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home

\$2,995

- Our charge includes a proportionate share of overhead costs, care of remains, transportation of remains to funeral home, and then to cemetery or crematory.

Green Burial Offerings – Burial Container not included

- As guided by the Green Burial Council, we offer the following services, **as well as in-home funerals**, in accordance with their rules and guidelines. For all Green Burials, embalming is not performed. Washing/cleaning of the deceased is only performed with non-toxic, biodegradable soaps/chemicals/oils.

Graveside Burial and Ceremony

\$4,000

- Our charge includes basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains, refrigerated storage (up to 5 days), preparation of remains, local transportation to cemetery, and filing of necessary paperwork.

Services at Funeral Home before Burial

\$6,000

- Our charge includes basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains, refrigerated storage (up to 5 days), preparation of remains, 1 hour visitation and 1 hour funeral service at funeral home or local venue, local transportation to cemetery, and filing of necessary paperwork.
