Picture Book Pre-K —1 grade



Picture Book Presenter – Grades PreK-1


- Adam Rex is the author and illustrator of more than forty books for kids.

- She has been chosen as one of Forbes 30 Inspirational Women and one of the Arab American Institute's 40 Under 40.





- He is also one of the founding hosts of the blog The Brown Bookshelf – a blog designed to push awareness of the myriad of African American voices writing for young readers.





Christina's presentation will be pre recorded from Australia.







- In January 2016, the Library of Congress, Every Child A Reader, and the Children's Book Council appointed Gene as the National Ambassador for Young People's Literature.





- She has worked in children's publishing for over a decade, editing and writing books for school library publishers.





Nicole Stott - Astronaut, Artist, Author

Young Adult (YA) High School

- Nicole is an astronaut and artist who creatively combines the awe and wonder of her spaceflight experience with her artwork, in order to inspire everyone's appreciation of our role as crewmates here on Spaceship Earth.
- A veteran NASA Astronaut with two spaceflights and 104 days living and working in space as a crew member on both the International Space Station (ISS) and the Space Shuttle. Personal highlights of her time in space include performing a spacewalk (10th woman to do so), flying the robotic arm to capture the first HTV, painting a watercolor, working with her crew mates and the ground team on science that is all about improving life on Earth, and of course the view out the window. She is also a NASA Aquanaut and was a crew member on an 18-day saturation dive mission at the Aquarius undersea laboratory.
- As an Artist, and now retired from NASA, Nicole combines her artwork and spaceflight experience to inspire creative thinking about solutions to our planetary challenges, to raise awareness of the surprising interplay between science and art, and to promote the amazing work being done every day in space to improve life right here on Earth. She is the founder of the <u>Space for</u> Art Foundation.
