Parking Lot Resurfacing Project

The parking lot project will begin on Monday, July 13, weather permitting.

While the excavation is occurring, the lot will be closed for about two days. We **will** be able to drive on the lot while the new base material is settling. The lot will be closed again, while the asphalt is laid, and again when the lines are painted.

The asphalt company is aware of our need to be accessible on Sundays and will make every effort to make sure that happens. So for Sunday worship, parking should be available in the lot, it just may be a more gravel-like/rocky surface.

We will keep you updated as the time gets closer.
