HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- I. NAME  
Court St. Louis-Maria CATHOLIC DAUGHTERS High School Scholarship Fund
- II. PURPOSE  
To inspire students to continue their education in the field of their choice.
- III. CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP
  - A. Two Five Hundred Dollar (\$500) scholarships per year to be awarded to each of two graduating seniors.
  - B. One five-hundred-dollar scholarship will be awarded to a Hamshire-Fannett graduate and one to an East Chambers graduate.
  - C. If a student has not enrolled in a college or university the first or second semester after graduation the scholarship is forfeited.
- IV. QUALIFICATIONS
  - A. Student must be of the Catholic Faith
  - B. Immediate family members of a Court St. Louis – Maria member, parent or grandparent, will have first consideration, unless said graduate is receiving a large scholarship.
  - C. Any Catholic student planning to attend a university, college or vocational school shall be eligible.
  - D. Applications are available through the high school counselor and St. Mary Church. Applications must be completed and returned to the Counselor's office or Youth Minister office by May 1.
  - E. All applicants' records shall be available to the scholarship committee.
- V. ALTERNATES
  - A. Two alternates per scholarship will be chosen at the time recipients are selected.
  - B. If a recipient is unable to utilize the scholarship by the second semester, the scholarship automatically goes to the first alternate. If the first alternate does not meet the requirements, then the scholarship will go to the second alternate.
- VI. SCHILARSHIP COMMITTEE
  - A. The scholarship committee will consist of three or four members of C.D.A. #2139.
  - B. The scholarship committee will meet and select recipients and alternates by mid May of each year and make names of recipients and alternates available to the High School Counselor, the C.D.A. Regent and Treasurer.
