CHECKING IN

Upon arrival at **Indiana University Southeast** on Monday, July 13th, Camp registration is between 9:30 -- 11:15 am EST. Check in will be in front of Grove Lodge (Map on next page). Please have medication ready to check-in with our camp nurse. Following check-in, the camper is free to get settled in. Huddle leaders and staff will be on hand to greet campers and answer any questions you might have. There are no accommodations for early arrivals, so your first provided meal is lunch is from 11:30 am – 12:15 pm EST and the official program begins with the Opening Ceremony at 12:30 pm EST.

ALL unpaid fees are due prior to arrival at camp.

Should you need to cancel your registration, all fees, **minus your \$75 deposit**, may be refunded if you cancel your enrollment prior to on-site camp registration. Substitutions of the same gender can be made prior to the start of camp.

***If you fail to cancel your registration and do not show up for camp, there is an additional \$50 no-show service fee.**

INSURANCE
