Council Meeting Notes from April

Council voted to approve another year of Football Mania. Starting early will enable us to sell tickets at the Country Fair. Stay tuned for more details.

Ed's work in improving our technology capabilities in the sanctuary was acknowledged.

Council asked the Communications Committee to get large signs advertising both the Summer Camp and the Pre-registration dates for TCNSK.

There was discussion about the new lights in the parking lot and efforts to find more users of both the field and our indoor spaces.

Two air conditioning units need to be replaced this year; the funds will come from the Designated Emergency Maintenance fund.

For the Attic Treasures sales at the Country Fair, a trial use of a Venmo account will be implemented. This trial does not include other parts of the fair.

99% of the pledges for the Pave the Way campaign have been fulfilled.

NO text books, out of date travel or technical publications, old, musty or torn books.


