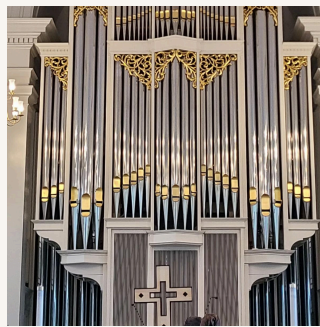

Fiction, nonfiction (paper back and hardcover) and children's books in good shape accepted. Donations may be left in Room 106.

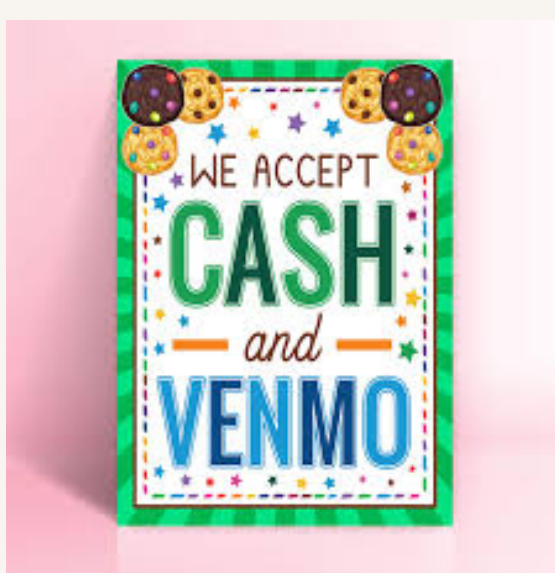
NO text books, out of date travel or technical publications, old, musty or torn books.
