And it is COOKIE TIME !

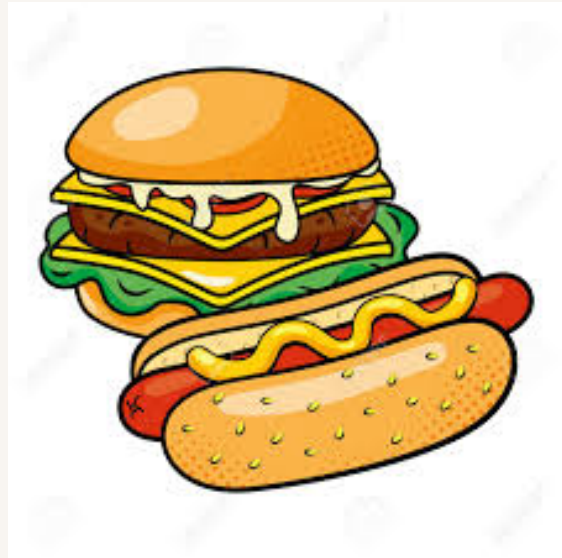
Our collection of sweets is once again running low. Please consider dropping off your favorite cookie in the kitchen to add to our supply for coffee hour. Thank you!
