## COUNTRY FAIR THANK YOU

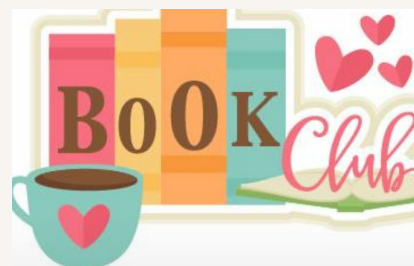
