An Interview with Linda Stone

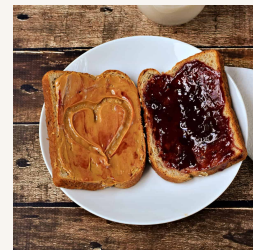
