MASS MINUTE BY DEACON EDWARD WINTER

We are called to full, conscious, active participation in the Mass. We are not all at the celebration of the Mass as mere spectators; we are participants. This is not a movie. This means that we respond to the priest celebrant in prayer which includes singing. Clearly, some people at Mass are not singing. To those who protest, "I can't sing," the obvious answer is, "Yes", you can. Perhaps you cannot sing very well but you can sing." At one time we had a pastor who, "could not carry a tune in a bushel basket," but he did the best he could. He gave back to God what God had given him. Bishop Robert Barron likes to point out that when we sing together, we sound pretty good, even though individually we may not. God is surely pleased when we offer back to him what he has given us, including our wants, needs, love, and our voices. We must be present to the Lord without holding back any part of ourselves.

Looking at another side of the issue, we know that there are members who have good singing voices which they keep to themselves. The choir needs those voices to augment our praise of our creator. If God gave you a gift, he wants you to share it.

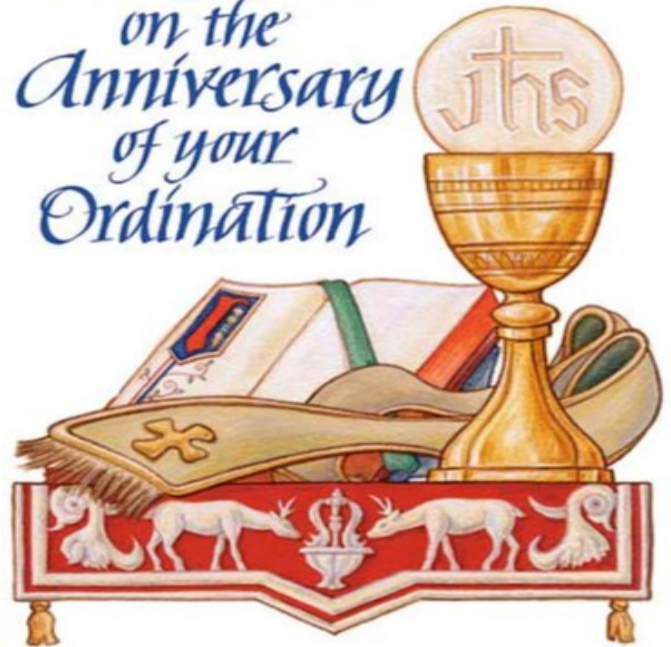
