## Mass Minute with Deacon Ed Winter

We will look at the difference between attending Mass and praying Mass. Attending is not just being physically present. Attending is paying attention. Similarly, praying the Mass is more than attending.

There are three forms of prayer: vocal (called oratio), Mental (meditatio), and silent, mystical union with God (contemplatio). In silent we can find the most intimate prayer and it is in silence that God speaks to us the most. We are called to Mass in union, in community, and yet, silence is an important part of Mass. We'll look at the aspect.

Years ago, Bishop Joseph Perry, our vicar at the time in Illinois, spoke about the value of people coming together, greeting each other, and exchanging news, etc., but advising that this be done in the parking lot or in the narthex because people in the church proper will be praying, meditating, and deserving quiet.

Mass begins with music, singing, and procession, reminding us of psalm 100, "Shout joyfully to the Lord all you lands, worship the Lord with cries of gladness, come before him with joyful song," but after this we are called to look into our hearts in a moment of silence. Again, before our opening prayer called the Collect, Father says, "Let us pray," and pauses for a moment of silence so that we can gather our thoughts from the world and bring them to prayer. Again and again, especially after Communion, we will be offered this opportunity. Many people find silence uncomfortable but we need to embrace it and learn its benefits.

#### Missionary Cooperation Appeal July 26th and 27th

Fr. Alejandro (Alex) Rodriguez, s.x. of the St. Franis Xavier Missionaries, will be preaching the Mission Appeal next weekend as part of the annual Missionary Cooperation Appeal.

Fr. Alex, born in Mexico, is a graduate of Catholic Theological Union in Chicago, and was ordained in Guadalajara, Mexico. He has served as missionary in the Philippines He has worked as the Vocation Director, Vicar at the Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish in the poverty-stricken area of the metro Manila, Spiritual Director at the St. Faustina Catholic School, Collaborator with the campus ministry of different universities in the Philippines and Rector of the Philosophy Seminary of the Xaverians in the Philippines. Fr. Alex is presently working in the field of Vocations and the Hispanic Ministry in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee as well as being the Rector at our mission center in Franklin, Wi. He is willing to share his mission experience with anyone interested.

Being exclusively a foreign mission society , the Xaverian Fathers and Brothers depend greatly on proceeds from this collection. They carry out their service in Bangladesh, Brazil, Burundi, Cameroon, Chad, Columbia , The Democratic Republic of Congo (formerly Zaire), France, Great Britain, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Mozambique, the Philippines, Sierra Leone, Spain, Taiwan, and the United States.
