

# St. Vincent de Paul St. Joseph Conference 920-388-9644

A couple weeks ago, on the Feast of Corpus Christi we heard the familiar Gospel story of "the Loaves and the Fishes." This is just one of many instances where we see Jesus swaying from his main mission, to address the souls of his followers, to demonstrate concern for their human needs. As Christians, we have a responsibility to spread the good news to our fellow man, but we also have a responsibility to help our friends with their worldly needs. You would be surprised how often the help we provide to our "Friends in Need" creates an opportunity for friendly Christian conversation that otherwise would not have occurred. More often than not, the conversation is initiated by those being helped. Maybe that was Christ's intention when he performed that miracle?

# Mass Minute with Deacon Ed Winter

After the first reading in the Mass, we hear selections from a psalm, what is called the responsorial psalm. The 150 psalms in the bible are songs of praise and thanksgiving composed by multiple authors over many years, from pre-exilic, pre-587 to post—exilic, post 539 BC. Most were composed for liturgical worship. 73 of the psalms are attributed to King David.

In the temple, the verses would be sung by two groups alternating. Today, when praying the Liturgy of the Hours in a group, we may follow the same pattern; half of the group will alternate with the other half singing verses and all together singing the response.

At least as early as the third century, psalms were recited at Mass. There are songs of praise, thanksgiving, and laments, both individual and communal with frequent expressions of trust. (USCCB)

Fr. Douglas Martis of Mundelein Seminary put together the *Mundelein Psalter*, an attempt to restore the temple tradition. The original music has been long lost but new chant tunes have been composed. The temple tradition continues today in the Mass in the psalms.
