Last week a woman from the community came to us. She had recently experienced a heart attack. Not only that but she had also fallen and fractured an eye socket, causing her to lose vision. She lives alone and has no support available when she is not working. Obviously, this leaves a lot of outstanding bills. However, as I said last week, God knows what you need.

Shortly after she called, Barb showed up at our door with an envelope full of money from the Memorial Day collection at St. Joseph Cemetery. In the mail we received a \$500 check from the One by One Homeless Services Grant. We try to thank each of our donors personally, but sometimes, as in these instances, we don't really know the individuals who God touched to provide for us. Please know that we greatly appreciate these gifts. We regularly pray for all our "Friends in Need" and we will be praying for you, as well.

Mass Minute with Deacon Ed Winter

Receiving Holy Communion in the hand is also acceptable and is preferred by most people. When doing so, we are instructed to hold out our hand, open and flat, palm up. If we are right handed, we should offer our left hand supported by our right. Then the minister can easily and safely place the Body of Christ in our palm and we can pick it up with our right hand and consume it.

Offering our hands together like a cup creates a risk of dropping the host, either by the minister or the communicant. Our hand should be open and flat. Grasping the host from the minister with thumb and forefinger is also undesirable and, perhaps, disrespectful. Receiving the Body and /or Blood of Christ is never routine or casual and must be regarded as a special gift from God no matter how often we are privileged to receive the Sacrament.
