MASS MINUTE BY DEACON EDWARD WINTER

People have been making music for a very long time, banging on a log with a stick, blowing on a grass leaf or a conch shell. There must be something primitive in our urge to make music. There is archaeological evidence of musical instruments going back to at least 38,000 BC!

"...There can hardly be anyone who is not moved by some kind of music. Music covers the whole gamut of emotions and is intricately bound up with important events in our lives from a mother singing her baby to sleep to a stadium full of people singing the national anthem." (The Encyclopedia of Music; Max Matthews -Wade and Wendy Thompson) Is it not fitting for music to be a part of our worship, an expression of our love and respect for our Lord?

Jubal, the great, great grandson of Cain was called the ancestor of all who played the lyre and the pipe. (Gen 5:20) David, around 1000 BC, composed half of the psalms and made music and danced before the Ark of God.
