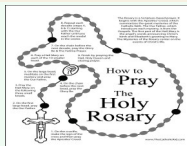

Mass Minute with Deacon Ed Winter

Preparing for the Mass begins before we leave home to go to the church. We need to "Approach God in the liturgy with the disposition of awe, wonder, reverence, humility, contrition, trust, praise, gratitude, and charity." (Dr. Edward Sri)

Then, after celebrating the Mass, what do we do, just go home and forget it until next Sunday NO, because we are sent. Since the fourth century, we are told, "Ite missa est," meaning, "you are dismissed." The word Mass is derived from *missa* meaning "sending." The celebration of the Eucharist is called "Holy Mass" (*missa*), "...because the liturgy is which the mystery of salvation is accomplished concludes with the sending forth (mission) of the faithful so that they may fulfill God's will in their lives." (CCC1332)

How do we do this? By "...glorifying the Lord by our lives." by "...loving and serving the Lord." by "...going (ing) in the peace of Christ." and by "...proclaiming the gospel of the Lord." We are not just let go, we are sent on a mission. If we change even a little of our lives, we change the world.

"As the Father sent me, so I send you."
