What is the Collect? It is part of the introductory Rite at the beginning of Mass. After the Penitential prayer (Lord have mercy...), and the Gloria, the celebrant says,

"Let us pray." The prayer that follows gathers the intentions of the people and sets the course of the Mass. Today we prayed, through the celebrant, to God, "Who founded all the commands of your sacred law upon love of you and of our neighbor."

All of God's laws, from the ten commandments to the laws of nature, including the law of gravity, are based on love. So we then turn to the Liturgy of the Word, God's word, to tell us how to live in accord with his law. Next, God's Word.
