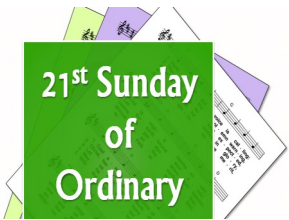

Community of Saint Paul Mission Appeals 2022

Denny Jacob has been a member of the Community of Saint Paul for over 10 years. He began his formation in the Dominican Republic, where he lived and studied for 5 years. There, he studied Philosophy at the *Instituto Filosofico Francisco Bobo*, run by the Jesuits in Santo Domingo. He also was involved in the developmental and pastoral projects run by the Community of Saint Paul in *La Sagrada Familia* Parish, located in the southwest part of the country. His pastoral work included presiding over celebrations of the word and some catechesis in the remote areas of the parish.

Currently, he is a seminarian for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee at Saint Francis de Dales Seminary in Saint Francis, Wisconsin.

In his appeals, Denny will be presenting the work of the Community of Saint Paul in the Dominican Republic.

**DEACON’S CORNER
By Deacon Mark**

“Welcome to the Deacon’s Corner. This will be a monthly update in the bulletin. We are blessed to have two permanent Deacons currently in our two parishes. To start off, what is a permanent Deacon? A Catholic Deacon is a member of the clergy. In the Catholic Church, “the clergy” consists of three groups of ordained ministers: Bishops, Priests, and Deacons. The title “deacon” comes from the Greek word diakonos, which means “servant.” A Deacon is ordained by the bishop into the Order of Deacons (commonly referred to as the diaconate). He is publicly and permanently configured to Christ the Servant and lives a life of service within the Church and the community. His threefold ministry includes: service of the word, service of liturgy, and service of charity, justice and pastoral outreach. The bible mentions Deacons in the following passages: Acts 6:1-6 and 1 Timothy 3:1-13. Both of our Deacons were ordained in other diocese and moved to Sturgeon Bay in the Green Bay Diocese. Deacon Ed was ordained in the Archdiocese of Chicago and Deacon Mark was ordained in the Archdiocese of Dubuque, Iowa.
