The sign of the Cross.

In the earliest days, followers of "The Way," later to be called Christians, would recognize each other by making a sign of the cross on their foreheads. It wasn't until the middle ages that the gesture was expanded to the forehead, chest, and both shoulders.

More important than the gesture, though, is what we say as we do it; "This thing I do, this prayer I offer, this work I begin, I do in the name..." When we were little, the good Dominican sisters would tell us to assess the good and bad of what we were about to do by asking ourselves, "Would I do this if my mother were watching?" Maybe I should promise myself the first thing in the morning, that everything I do today, I will do in the Name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
