MASS MINUTES By Deacon Ed

The word "gospel" means "Good News." We might think of the German _Gut Spiel_or even_Gott Spiel._
The Gospels stand out and have a special place in the scriptures because they are the story of Jesus of Nazareth, his teachings, life, death, and resurrection and contain some quotations of Jesus himself. Apparently it was Mark who wrote the first one and applied the term "gospel" to it. The gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke are similar in many points and arrangement and so are called the synoptic gospels. The gospel according to John differs from them in outline and approach, a more theologic view of the story of the messiah. Because they have a special place in the scriptures, the gospels are proclaimed by clergy. We welcome our Lord, Jesus, by standing while the gospel is proclaimed as the assembled Jews stood when Ezra read from the book of the law. (Nehemiah 8:5).

If you would like to have a Mass said for a loved one we have started to fill in next year and there are a lot open. Get your Mass in the books. They are \$10.00 a Mass.
