Having received gifts of bread and wine from the people, the celebrant will prepare to offer them to God. The deacon, or the celebrant if no deacon is assisting him, will pour the wine into the chalice and add a little water while praying quietly, "By the mystery of this water and wine, may we come to share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity."
