A few weeks ago, my son-in-law asked me, “You poured a little water into the wine. What was that all about? Having received gifts of bread and wine from the people, the celebrant will prepare to offer them to God. The deacon, or the celebrant if no deacon is assisting him, will pour the wine into the chalice and add a little water while praying quietly, “By the mystery of this water and wine, may we come to share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity.” The people do not hear this. God taking on human nature while retaining his divine nature is certainly a mystery, something we can express but not fully understand. This mystery is further extended by God sharing his divinity with us, the purpose of communion and the ultimate purpose of our lives. Next: Offering the gifts.
