

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENT OF FIRST

RECONCILIATION for those children, in Year 3 or above, who attend a non-Catholic Primary School, Saturday, 31st January at 11.00 a.m. at St Peter's Church. Each weekly Session will last approx. 1 hour & parents/guardians are expected to stay with their child. The Sacrament will be celebrated on Saturday, 28th March at St Columba's Church.
