Tasting Notes The Black Ankle Estate (Estate) is our flagship, limited-production, Bordeaux-style blend that is only made from excellent vintage years. The 2016 Estate is our second release and it is a full-bodied, dry wine that has juicy acidity and firm tannins. There's lingering aromas and flavors of red and dark fruits, sweet wood, and vanilla that are laced with notes of tobacco, chocolate, and baking spice before the wine finishes with a lingering warm, peppery finish.
