Tasting Notes Our 2018 Rolling Hills uses six of our seven red wine grapes (only Pinot Noir is missing). 2018 was a difficult year for grape growing, but our winemaker's deftness in the winery led to this full-bodied gem featuring a soft, easy drinking palate. Red and dark fruit flavors segue into a long finish filled with plum, tobacco, and pepper spice notes.
