**Tasting Notes** Medium-bodied and complex, our 2019 Grüner Veltliner Sud showcases aromas and flavors of citrus (lemon, lime, and tangerine), with starfruit, and white stone fruit that lead to a palate that is full of bright acidity, mineral and white pepper notes. There is an underlying floral note as well as hints of herb and asparagus.
