

"These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you,


that everything written about me in the law of Moses


and in the prophets and psalms must be fulfilled." Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures.

The Gospel of Luke

Points to Ponder

- 1. What Questions Arise in Your Heart? What robs us of interior peace? Jesus knows the many questions we have in our hearts. Let's make an act of entrusting ourselves to Jesus' love and thank him for his presence through the gift of peace. We need to renew this act as often as worries assail us.
- 2. It Is Myself! What is it that makes us believe? When we contemplate the wounds of Christ in his risen body, his body the Church, his power and grace can prevail over the damage, scars, pains, and sufferings we endure. Let's open our hearts to share with the Lord any hesitation to forgive those who have hurt us. Let's believe in Jesus' healing power through the Church.
- 3. Scripture Revealed: The Scriptures already hinted at a Messiah- a suffering servant who would rise from the dead, forgive sin, and be preached to all nations. Jesus, risen from the dead, fulfills this prophecy. By his resurrection, we know that our whole person, body, and soul will one day be resurrected. Praise Jesus for the beautiful eventuality of our own resurrection!
- 4. Conversing with Christ: Lord, I place my worries and preoccupations in your hands. To your providence, I entrust the causes of my concerns. May I always live with a belief in the power of the Resurrection to be working for good in all circumstances. I know you are with me. Grant me the courage to speak of you and your love with the prudence to know what to do and what to say, drawing from your word in the Scriptures. This is the peace that reconciles sister to brother, black to white, rich and poor, young and old. But not a peace that is quiet in the face of oppression and injustice.

This is peace with God, the peace that passes understanding.

Seeing your Life through the Lens of the Gospel

- 1. When we are not expecting it to happen, even a good event can startle us. So it was with the disciples when Jesus appeared to them. He sought to calm them and helped them to see the good news behind what had initially alarmed them. Who has been a Jesus person for you by helping you to find meaning and good news in life?
- 2. Jesus helped the disciples to find new hope, but he did not give them easy answers. He asked them to see the facts before their eyes. He wanted them to learn from the lived experience they were having. As a parent, teacher, friend, or guide, have you been a Jesus person to another, helping him/her to find hope and purpose in life by learning from his/her experiences? Who has done this for you?
- 3. Jesus opened their minds to 'understand the scriptures', and the effect was transformative. Perhaps there have been times when a new and deeper understanding of scripture has had a transformative impact on you. Recall the experience and give thanks for those who opened the scriptures for you.
- 4. The resurrection experience empowered the disciples to be witnesses. Unexpected possibilities for the future surfaced when it seemed that hope had gone. When have new possibilities opened for you after a 'resurrection' experience: recovery of health when it did not seem possible, new opportunities after failure or disappointment, inner healing after a deep hurt, etc?






