

This is why the Father loves me,


because I lay down my life in order to take it up again.

The Gospel of John

Today, we hear much on the importance of social services, opportunities, mental health, and well-being. However, imagine we had a world where everyone had a good job, where the best services of physical and mental health were available, where the best roads and facilities were in place. Life might be good, but would we all be happier? Would this guarantee that the levels of crime would fall? Would less people be addicted to drugs and alcohol? The answer, of course, is no because the human heart longs for more than money, jobs, facilities, and opportunities. The human heart longs for love, for meaning, for family, and to know that we matter to someone. Every human life longs to directly experience the love of God which keeps it alive.

And when we read the Gospel on this Sunday, this is precisely Jesus' message to us. He says: 'The sheep that belong to me listen to my voice. I know them.' We belong to a God who knows us and loves us. We are not the result of a chance, but are willed by the God who made us human. He says: 'They listen to my voice.' Deep in our hearts we recognize the voice of God's truth who has placed his Spirit in us. We know that we have a vocation, a calling. We now what is right and what is wrong, what is true and what is false. We know that we are made for more than this world, for eternal life, and we are on that journey together. Therefore, every life is precious, sacred, and unique.

If the Church is to be a voice that defends the dignity and vocation of all, then the leadership and presence of priests and religious is crucial. We ask you to please pray for us in our vocations and to pray for and encourage vocations in our parishes and diocese - that those who sense the voice of the Good Shepherd calling them to serve as priests and religious may listen to that voice and respond with faith and generosity.

Seeing your Life through the Lens of the Gospel

- 1. Our relationship with those 'in charge' of us changes when we sense that not only are they in charge, but they care. Remember the difference this made for you as a child and give thanks for the caring adults who were part of your life.
- 2. The good shepherd 'lays down his life for the sheep'. When has your care for another led you to 'lay down your life' for that person, e.g., as a friend, parent, spouse, son or daughter? When have you known another to do this for you?
- 3. Jesus speaks of the freedom of the Good Shepherd in laying down his life. Faced with the needs of others, we can at times feel trapped into looking after them, caught by duty, obligation, or guilt. We can become like the hired hands doing a job without care for the person. Perhaps you have experienced both attitudes, caring for others under duress and caring by your free choice. What difference did it make when you chose to care for the other, even in circumstances where you had little option?
- 4. What do these experiences of love and care in human relationships reveal to you about God's love for you?





BELOW IS AN OVERVIEW OF EACH SESSION:

Session 1: What's Our Story?

The Bible is the story of God's love for us. He created us out of love, redeemed us by his love, and transforms us in his love.

Session 2: Who Is Jesus?

Jesus is both God and man, therefore he reveals who God is in relation to us. Jesus asked Simon Peter, "Who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15) He asks this same question of us: who do you say Jesus is?

Session 3: Am I Saved?

Salvation is a gift from God through Jesus Christ that requires our "yes.'

Session 4: Why a Church?

Jesus didn't simply leave us a written message or instruction manual to follow. He gave us a living, dynamic Church where we encounter him personally and allow ourselves to be transformed into his likeness.

Session 5: God Is With Us

God's presence in the Old Testament foreshadows the gift of the Eucharist, one of the seven sacraments of the Church. Jesus established the Eucharist to give us strength and accompany us at every moment of our earthly journey.

Session 6: The Story of the Eucharist

The story of the Eucharist can be traced throughout Scripture. From Genesis to the present day, this session explores how the Cross is the new Tree of Life, and the Eucharist is its fruit.

Session 7: Bread for the Journey

The Eucharist sustains us on our spiritual journey. Our participation at Mass through the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist is an offering of thanksgiving to God. We are then sent forth to share what we have received.




